- **Free of charge** — no payment is ever requested, at any stage
- **Anonymous if you wish** — anonymous reports are admissible
- **Without retaliation** — no sanction or exclusion for having reported

Acknowledgement within 24 hours. Reasoned response within 30 working days. For sexual exploitation, abuse and harassment, a distinct pathway handles the report **within 72 hours**.

Approaching one level is never a precondition for approaching another: any person may go directly to the level of their choice, including the Green Climate Fund.
